**Preparation of Quotations:**

You are requested to quote for the items given in Annex-A, by submitting a signed & sealed quotation on the company's letterhead.

This procurement process will be conducted in accordance with the World Bank Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers (November 2020). The acceptable terms and conditions of the lowest, responsive quotation shall be incorporated in the Purchase Order.

**Terms and Conditions:**

1. Suppliers shall supply, deliver, install, and ensure proper functioning of all goods in accordance with the technical specifications provided in Annex A.
2. Bidders shall be eligible and shall not be under suspension or debarment by the World Bank. Government-owned enterprises may participate only if they are legally and financially autonomous and operate under commercial law.

3. Bidders shall be legally registered and shall provide valid registration documents.
4. Bidders shall demonstrate relevant experience in the supply of similar goods. Evidence of at least two similar contracts may be provided.
5. The goods offered shall be new, unused, and of the latest model, and shall comply fully with the required technical specifications. A detailed compliance sheet shall be submitted indicating compliance or deviations.
6. Bidders shall provide after-sales service support within Karachi, either directly or through an authorized service partner.
7. The Supplier shall provide standard warranty from the date of acceptance of goods.
8. Quotations shall include price schedule, technical compliance, company profile, registration documents, and supporting evidence of experience.
9. Prices shall be quoted in Pakistani Rupees, inclusive of all applicable taxes, duties, transportation, delivery, installation, and any other associated costs.
10. The Purchaser will evaluate and compare the quotations determined to be substantially responsive to the technical and commercial requirements and shall award the contract to the bidder offering the lowest evaluated quotation.
11. A quotation shall be considered substantially responsive if it meets all the requirements of the RFQ without material deviation.
12. Delivery, installation, and commissioning shall be completed within 30 days from the date of issuance of the Purchase Order.
13. Payment shall be made after delivery, installation, inspection, and acceptance of the goods by the Purchaser, upon submission of invoice and supporting documents. No advance payment shall be made.
14. Quotations shall remain valid for a period of 30 days from the date of submission.
15. The Purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject any quotation and to cancel the procurement process in accordance with the applicable procurement regulations.
16. The procurement process shall be conducted in accordance with the World Bank Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers (November 2020).
17. The Supplier shall comply with the World Bank Anti-Corruption Guidelines.
18. The Supplier shall permit the World Bank, upon request, to inspect accounts and records relating to the performance of the contract.
